On Wednesday, 12th June, six of our Year 8 students attended a Mathematics Enrichment Day at Highgate School along with other schools from North and North West London.




The students had a great time and even took a break from their hard work to enjoy the beautiful grounds of Highgate School.

The students worked very hard during the session and the Imam was pleased to receive a Thank You card from the staff and students at Woodside.




Science Museum Trip


