Wilful intimidation and/or threats.



Physical and/or sexual assault and battery.



Emotional and/or psychological abuse.



Criminal harassment (i.e. stalking).

We are a local charity; 82% of our service users and many volunteers and donors are based in Hackney, we also support people in Haringey and other parts of North London.

Home-Start is a charity that trains volunteers to support and provide for families who are in need of help that have a child under the age of 12.

They support around 70 different families in Haringey, Hackney and Waltham Forest and many other families across the UK.

The poverty rate in Haringey is 33%
whilst child poverty is 35%

16.2% of people get out-of-work benefits,
which is worse than most London boroughs

20% of people in Haringey get low pay.

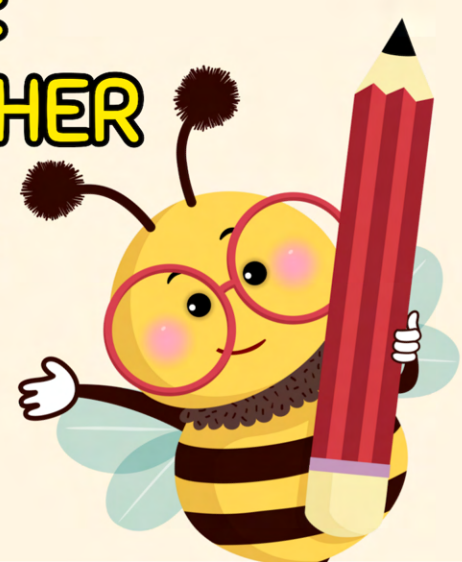
